## Important Information...

#### **School Routines**

- 7. Attendance and Punctuality. We expect our students to attend school on all school days (unless advised otherwise) and be punctual for school. Whilst the reporting time¹ for students is 7.30 am from 3 January 2024 (Wednesday) onwards, students are encouraged to be in school by 7.25 am to allow sufficient time to get ready for the flag-raising ceremony scheduled at 7.30 am. P1 and P2 students will report to the Indoor Sports Hall (ISH), whereas P3 to P6 students will gather at the Multi-Purpose Hall (MPH). Students arriving after 7.30 am will be considered late. Punctuality is a virtue that we would like to advocate in our students. As such, we encourage parents to partner the school to inculcate the importance of being punctual for school. All students will be dismissed² at 1.30 pm unless there are after-school activities.
- 8. Any absence from school must be accompanied by a medical certificate (MC) or letter (including email) from parents. However, the school only accepts up to 5 letters (including email) for absence from school per semester. Please avoid taking your child out of school for extended family vacation during the school term, as we would like to honour the protected curriculum time for the year.
- 9. <u>Communications</u>. All official communications with parents will be done through Parents Gateway (PG). We would like to encourage all parents to go through the notifications sent on PG so that you are kept abreast of important information and where necessary, provide timely consent for your child's participation in programmes and activities organised by the school. We urge parents to refrain from contacting your child's teachers after 6.00 pm on school days, on non-school days and weekends, unless the matter requires urgent attention.

10. <u>Student Handbook 2024</u>. The Student Handbook 2024 has been issued to your child on 3 January (Wednesday). This handbook serves as a valuable resource containing information on school policies, operation details and key information of the school. It also facilitates communication between parents and the teachers. We kindly request that parents ensure your child brings the handbook to school every day. As the Student Handbook has been funded by the school, please note that each student is entitled to receive only one copy. Subsequent acquisition of the Student Handbook 2024 will be charged at a cost, subject to availability.

## Calendar Of Events (COE)

11. To keep parents informed in advance of important school/level events, we would like to direct parents' attention to the termly COE. Please refer to <a href="Enclosure 1">Enclosure 1</a> for the Term 1 COE. Moving forward, the COE will be made available in PG. More information will be shared in the next Open Letter.

#### Safety and Security

- 12. <u>Student Well-Being</u>. If your child is unwell, please ensure that he/she stays at home and seeks medical attention if necessary. If your child is recovering from respiratory-related illnesses, please encourage him/her to exercise social responsibility by wearing a mask should your child report to the school. Should your child be unwell or develop flu-like symptoms while in school, we will contact parents to fetch your child. We appreciate your support and will continue to work with you closely. Let us all do our part to exercise personal and social responsibility and stay safe.
- 13. The safety and security of our students is of utmost importance. As we begin the year, we would like to direct parents to the security and emergency measures found in the school website (<a href="mailto:sembawangpri.moe.edu.sg/our-school/securityandemergencymeasures">securityandemergencymeasures</a>).
- 14. Road Safety. We seek the assistance of parents to emphasise the importance of road safety to your child as our students resume the routine of travelling to and from school. Do remind your child to always exercise caution and care on the road. Specifically, they are to use pedestrian crossings, practise the Kerb Drill when crossing the road, obey traffic signals, avoid crossing in front of stationary vehicles or in between vehicles as the drivers may not see them, avoid running, playing or using personal devices (such as mobile phones) when crossing the road, and use the footpath and walkway instead of walking on the side of the road.

#### **Student Matters**

- 15. <u>Co-Curricular Activities (CCA)</u>. CCAs provide an important platform for the holistic development of your child. In 2024, CCAs will start in Term 1 Week 2 (week of 8 to 12 January). Due to the different CCA training days, the respective teachers-in-charge will be sending out the CCA schedules via PG in due course.
- 16. <u>National School Games (NSG) 2024</u>. The annual NSG is Singapore's largest and most extensive annual youth sports event that will be conducted from January to August 2024. Due

to the different competition dates, the respective teachers-in-charge will be sending out the NSG schedules via PG in due course.

17. <u>P3 & 4 SwimSafer</u>. Swimming is an important life skill which will be imparted to all Primary 3 and Primary 4 students in Term 1 through the SwimSafer 2.0 programme. The swimming lessons will be conducted at external venues. Please note the details of SwimSafer 2.0 (see Table 2).
